**Shoot for a Great Cause at River Legacy's Sporting Clay Shoot Fundraiser!**

**ARLINGTON, Texas** – River Legacy Foundation is hosting its 13<sup>th</sup> annual Sporting Clay Shoot on Friday, May 6<sup>th</sup> to benefit environmental education programs at River Legacy Nature Center in Arlington, TX. This event is held each year in support of River Legacy Nature Center's programs which include Nature School, summer camps, and field trips for students who attend an array of school districts across the DFW area. The Sporting Clay Shoot will be held at Defender Outdoors Clay Sports Ranch, located at 8270 Aledo Road, Fort Worth, TX 76126. Prices are \$200 per shooter and \$800 per team of four, with sponsorships starting at \$1,000. Tournament highlights include free ammo, 100 rounds of clays, breakfast and lunch, beer tickets, raffles, and an award ceremony.

Participants can purchase tickets for a variety of raffles and partake in a silent auction which features a Tower Shoot for two for the 2022-23 season. The gun raffle includes prizes like an A400 Beretta Action Bronze and a Benelli Ethos Field, while the anticipated cooler raffle will give lucky winners the chance to win items like a three-month membership at Defender Outdoors Clay Sports Ranch and free golf in Arlington.

Shooters at River Legacy's Sporting Clay Shoot may also put their accuracy and marksmanship to the test at the Firebird targets, in which success is based on how close a hit is to dead-on-center. To boost competitive spirits, participants who hit these Firebird targets will be entered into a drawing to win additional prizes.
